

Rock Creek Booster Club Minutes
January 14, 2009

The Rock Creek Booster Club convened at 6 p.m., January 14, 2009 in the Media Center at Rock Creek High School. The following members were present: Jennifer Hill, Sue Yenzler, Roxie Zoeller, Mary Altenhofen, Deb Srna, Robin Knoblauch, and Debbie Hodges. Scott Harshbarger was also present.

Sue passed out copies of the treasurer's report. She informed the club of the amount made at the basketball meal on January 9, 2009. The meal brought in \$517.54, and the concession stand profit is \$336.04.

Robin gave an update on apparel. She said that she has been in contact with GTM to discuss charges sent. There are more RC stadium seats for boosters and patrons to purchase. Robin also said there are plenty of new items to sell. The group voted to give two seats to long-time supporters, Dean and Edna May Taylor. There was discussion concerning places to store, containers to move, and ways to better display the apparel. It also was suggested that the apparel committee look into purchasing small special items to sell.

Sue reported that membership has stayed the same at 29 Mustang Boosters and 43 Silver Boosters. Discussion took place about when to give \$50 toward a camera to Mr. Miller for use by the Debate and Forensics teams.

There will be a Booster Club drawing at the January 20 wrestling match and the February 24 basketball game. These two nights are senior nights. Robin agreed to assemble the prizes from the apparel items in stock.

A scholarship committee is being organized by Carrie Andrade to select Rock Creek students from applications to receive a Booster Club Scholarship. Boosters are encouraged to volunteer to be on this committee.

There were no reports given by parent liaisons from high school or junior high sports and activities.

No further discussion took place concerning a Booster Club-sponsored Junior High Fun Night on Friday, April 24, 2009. Last meeting's suggestion was to have two drawings for students, and also a drawing for the adults helping with the Fun Night for one free 2009 Booster Club membership.

Mr. Harshbarger informed the group of the topics of concern in the athletic department. The freshman boys' class has a large number wanting to play sports. Changing the Activities and Athletic Banquets format was discussed further. More discussion took place about changing the two banquets into one. Mr. Harshbarger said the evening would be longer, but he envisioned an exciting evening for all.

Some banquet committee reports were presented. The decorations committee said the decorations were taken care of at this time. Ricky's Café needs to be contacted to see if our contract can be changed to allow for the consolidation/change to the banquets.

The next Booster Club meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 11 at 6 p.m. in the Media Center. All Boosters and interested parents are invited to attend.
