

Rock Creek Booster Club Minutes
December 10, 2008

The Rock Creek Booster Club convened at 6:00 p.m., December 10, 2008 in the Media Center at Rock Creek High School. The following members were present: Carrie Andrade, Erin Duncan, April Garetson, Jennifer Hill, Debbie Hodges, Eric Scott, Sue Yenzler and Roxie Zoeller. Scott Harshbarger was also present.

Sue passed out copies of the Treasurer's report. She also reminded the members that the approved minutes of the last meeting (October 8, 2008) are on the school website.

The January 9, 2009 basketball meal fundraiser was discussed. The meal will consist of sloppy joes, chips, dessert and a drink for \$4. Carrie will send out the e-mail to members asking for donations and workers. April will take the lead in planning/scheduling of this fundraiser. Sue will contact Mrs. Booth to put a notice in the program and will get the beginning cash. Eric will prepare the flyer and will forward a copy to Mr. Harshbarger to send to Silver Lake. Jennifer stated Farmer's State Bank is providing ice cream that game.

Sue reported we currently have 29 mustang boosters and 43 silver boosters.

Farmer's State Bank plans to continue the Fan of the Game program at all home basketball games. It was decided to have a Booster drawing at the January 20 wrestling match and the February 24th basketball game. These two nights are the Senior/Parent night. Those members present voted to have the drawing be for a sling-bag and uni-sex T-shirt. Carrie is to notify the apparel committee of this decision.

Although the apparel committee chairpersons were unable to attend the meeting tonight, they submitted a report. "We have a full inventory ready for the first home game. We have 6 booster seats (I believe) left for sale so they will go fast."

There was nothing to report by the scholarship or banquet committees.

Parent Liaison reports were given by all liaisons in attendance. Since the beginning of the school year, the Booster Club has provided support for the following high school programs: BPA, cheerleading, cross country, FCCLA, football, HS Play, and NHS.

There was a discussion about what the Booster Club could do for the junior high students. It was decided to host a Junior High Game/Fun night on Friday, April 24th, 2009. As part of this game night, there will be 2 drawings for the students

and also a drawing from the names of all adults helping with the function for one free 2009 Booster Club membership.

Mr. Miller approached his liaison about the possibility of the Booster Club helping with the purchase of a special camera to be used by the Debate and Forensic teams. It was voted to donate \$50 toward the purchase of this camera.

Mr. Harshbarger talked about the football facilities and about wanting to make some changes to the activity/athletic banquets. They're currently looking at combining the two banquets, having students still do some activities like a debate, a forensics presentation, having the jazz band play during a team highlight show, etc. He asked that everyone think about it and he would like to continue the discussion at the next meeting.

The next Booster Club meeting will be held Wednesday, January 14, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. in the Media Center.
