

Rock Creek Booster Club Minutes
September 12, 2007

The Rock Creek Booster Club convened at 6:00 p.m., September 12, 2007 in the Cafeteria at Rock Creek High School. Sue passed out copies of the monthly Treasurer's report. We have a current balance of \$5,614.18.

April discussed the football meal fundraiser. We are still in need of monetary donations for meat, charcoal and lighter fluid. She feels confident we'll get enough donations and volunteers. Set-up will begin between 4:00-4:30 on September 14th.

Robin stated that apparel sales are going good. Some of the t-shirts from Coach Beam are on back order and the pink jerseys from GTM are out until October but the majority of purchases have been delivered to the patrons.

Sue stated that the Booster Club membership is as follows: 18 Business Boosters, 27 Mustang Boosters and 42 Silver Boosters. She is still having new members sign up at the home football games. Robin created thank you notes for all Business Booster advertisers. The individual making the ad sale will deliver these thank yous along with a decal to the business.

It was decided to have a "Booster Salute" drawing for a stadium blanket at the Silver Lake football game. We will also have a drawing at Volleyball's Parent Night on October 16th. This drawing will be for Booster Club members (adult members) only and the member must be present to win.

The purchase of poster paints for use by the cheerleaders was discussed. The Cheerleading Parent Reps will visit with the sponsor concerning their needs and is authorized to spend up to \$100 for supplies.

The Cross Country Parent Rep has requested that Booster Club purchase a sunshade for their use at the meets. This sunshade needs to be at least a 10 x 10 and must have detachable walls to help block the cold wind. April will look at Sam's Club for this item when she's making purchases for the meal on Friday.

It was decided to check into purchasing a larger tent for the Track team a little later in the school year.

Sue will create a form for the Parent Rep's to use when requesting approval for purchase of needed items for their sport/activity

Cathy Minihan stated that the special education class would like to make sack lunches for teams for \$2 per lunch. This project allows the students to learn important hands-on skills.
