**ZAP:** Zeros Aren't Permitted

**WHY:** To encourage students to get their work done and show them that by doing so will allow them to succeed in class. We will no longer allow students to choose to fail. We as educators want to help them learn to be more responsible for their education. We care!

**Student will be considered ineligible for participation in activities if:**

1. They are failing 2 or more classes.
2. They have 1 F and a ZAP in THAT class.

STUDENT CAN GET OUT OF ATTENDING HELPS IF THEY NO LONGER MEET THE  
CRITERIA ABOVE.

**Eligibility – Daily/Weekly**

1. Any student who is failing 2 or more classes.
2. Any student with 1 F and a ZAP in THAT class.

**ZAP CARDS**

1. ZAP CARDS are given for missing or unfinished work.
2. Students with ZAP CARDS will report to a help session during Advisor time until the ZAP CARD is completed.
3. Students will not be ZAPPED for 0's on quizzes or tests if that was their score. They can be ZAPPED for quizzes or tests to make them up during Advisor time.
4. IF you ZAP a student when they are absent, mark the ABSENT box on the ZAP card and the DATE it is due.
5. Students with extended time for assignments can be ZAPPED on the date due for others but remember they have extended time. The date they finish will be marked on the ZAP CARD.
6. TA's will pick up all ZAP CARDS 10 minutes prior to the end of EACH PERIOD. IF an assignment was due that period you must do a ZAP CARD for the student.
7. The ZAP LIST will be sent to all teachers daily.
